RULES & INFORMATION

In the event of 'B' teams playing, a school must provide an umpire per team.

The format will be as per the circulated draw and based on '*good balls*' per match. This will eliminate any intentional or unintentional time-wasting or teams being penalised by poor bowlers.

A squad can consist of up to 15 players. Substitutions (fielding and batting) may only happen when the ball is 'dead'. If you intend to make batting substitutions during play, then your players need to wear numbered bibs.

Each team must provide their own NRA approved match ball (no incrediballs please), and their own First Aid kit.

Scoring will be as follows:

5 pts win, 3 pts score draw, 1 pt for scoring half or more of the winning teams score, 0 pts for a loss.

If there is a tie at the end of the section games then positions will be decided upon 'rounders difference'. If still a draw then 'rounders scored' will be counted and then if necessary 'rounders against'
