Join our Bursary 100 Club

The 100 Club is a simple and rewarding way to support The Jayne Triffitt Bursary Fund. 100 families are invited to join the 100 Club who each commit to donate £100 per term.

As a member, you will be entered into an annual prize draw to win a substantial cash prize.

How does it work?

The 100 Club will launch once 100 families have joined. Each family will make a donation of £100 per term via standing order. These monies will be 'ring fenced' and used to fund one full bursary each year. The cash prize will be funded out of remaining monies in the 100 Club account.

At the end of each academic year all 100 Club members, who have donated a full year's subscription, will be entered into a prize draw for the chance to win the cash prize.

You may join the 100 Club at any time, however to qualify for entry to the annual prize draw, your application and first payment must be received by 30th November of that academic year.

Benefits of 100 Club membership

100 Club will serve to create longevity for the Jayne Triffitt Bursary Fund scheme through the regularity of termly donations from its members.

At capacity, 100 Club will fund one full bursary every year (based on the day/tuition fees).

100 Club members' donations are 'ring fenced' and accounted for separately to other gifts donated to the Jayne Triffitt Bursary Fund.

100 Club members will be entered into an annual prize draw, held at the end of each academic year, where one lucky member will win a substantial cash prize.

100 Club members will receive regular updates from the Development team as well as invitations to exclusive 100 Club member events throughout the year such as a Governor's Dinner, an evening with the Head, Guest Speaker events and a Summer party.

100 Club members may still make separate donations to the Jayne Triffitt Bursary Fund or the Woldingham School Foundation via the usual routes, if they wish.





Rules of the 100 Club

1. The Jayne Triffitt Bursary 100 Club will operate a Small Lottery as defined by the Gambling Act 2005. The Woldingham School Foundation will appoint a subcommittee to run The Jayne Triffitt Bursary Fund 100 Club and the organiser will be authorized and appointed by the Foundation Development Committee.

2. Woldingham School reserves the right to alter the Rules of the 100 Club as necessary. Participants will be notified of changes. In no circumstances will changes retrospectively disadvantage any participants. The current up-to-date rules will be shown on the Woldingham School Foundation's web page www.woldinghamschool.co.uk/foundation

3. All profits made by the 100 Club will be paid to The Jayne Triffitt Bursary Fund.

4. Members must commit to pay £100 per term for a minimum of three terms. Participants must be 16 or over. Payments may be made either (a) by termly standing order (three payments of £100) or (b) by annual cheque (£300).

5. The Prize Draw will take place once a year in the Summer Term.

6. Members who have not made their first payment by 30th November will not be entered for the prize draw in that academic year.

7. The annual cash prize (£1000 minimum) will be paid out to the winner by cheque before the start of the next academic year.

8. Prize winnings will be paid out in person or by post. Winner's name is available on request.

9. The winner will have the opportunity to re-gift their prize to the fund if they wish.

10. Woldingham School may terminate 100 Club at any time and will offer to repay participants' payments made in advance.
