



BOARDERS – WHAT TO BRING

UNIFORM

All uniform has been previously listed on the Uniform List, and you should already either have purchased your uniform, or made an appointment with Mrs White (email: whitem@woldinghamschool.co.uk). The following additional items will be required. ***These items may be purchased from any leading store but, unfortunately, are not available from the school:***

- SHOES – Black or navy leather flat-heeled shoes (not suede or patent – no platforms, wedged heels). Two pairs, one slightly more formal is recommended by the Head of Sixth Form for girls in L6 and U6
- Navy or black winter coat
- 1 pair trainers (Sports not leisure, ensure substantial sole)
- 1 coloured swimming towel
- 1 tennis racquet (compulsory for Years 7-9 summer)
- 10 pairs pants / 7 pairs socks/tights; underwear as necessary
- 1 full length dressing gown
- 3 nightdresses/pyjamas
- 1 pair soft bedroom slippers (optional – 1 pair of plastic soled slider type sandals)
- 1 bath towel (not robes) with loops for hanging
- 3 hand towels
- 1 single size continental quilt/duvet (with 2 removable lightweight washable covers)
(we recommend that girls practise putting the duvet cover on the duvet before joining!)
2 under sheets (optional as will be provided by school)
- 1 or 2 pillows and pillow cases
- 1 small weekend bag/case
- Alarm clock (battery operated)

- Mug (for Years 9 to 11)
- Re-usable plastic cup
- A knife, fork and spoon, for evening use for snacks
- 1 large suitcase (not a trunk please)
- 1 shoe cleaning kit
- Years 9-12 – School bag, black or navy – **optional**. (Year 7 and 8 are provided with a school navy rucksack and this will be charged to your account at the beginning of term)

We recommend that all Boarders bring an all-black outfit and a smart outfit for House and Christmas Dinner events. Please also provide a smart casual outfit for girls to wear to Mass (for example smart trousers and top).

Computers – IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ALL PUPILS BRING A LAPTOP OR TABLET COMPUTER

Please note that the School computers are available to all pupils, for skype (limited times), email, and internet access.

Other Miscellaneous Items that may be required

- Hairdryer and brush/comb
- Plate, bowl and cutlery – optional for those in Sixth Form
- Mug – compulsory for Year 9 onwards
- Table lamp – Year 10 onwards
- Single size blanket/fleece throw
- Casual clothes for weekend
- Warm winter boots/wellingtons
- Lightweight waterproof jacket
- Umbrella
- Toiletry bag and toiletries (including deodorant, shampoo, shower gel, toothbrush, toothpaste, flannel, soap, sanitary towels – also available from the School Health Centre)
- Any medication that you have been prescribed – clearly labelled with the name and form. (This must be declared to the Health centre)
- Pencil case with writing pens, coloured pencils, maths set (protractor, set square, compass, and pencil), ruler, and rubber. (Extra stationary is available from the School shop)

- Scientific calculator
- Cuddly toy for bedtime
- Summer hat, sunglasses, and sun cream (summer term)
- Nail scissors and nail file
- Mobile phone (only phones on **Vodafone** network work at Woldingham)
- iPod or similar with headphones – *optional*
- 3 combination padlocks for Years 7 and 8, 1 padlock only for Year 9

All personal belongings must be labelled with laundry number and/or name.

Provided by the School

- Laundry service for all uniform and bedding
- Laundry of home clothes for all full boarding pupils in Years 7 and 8
- Washing powder and machines (for weekend use for full Boarders only – Year 9 upwards for home clothes). Please bring your own washing detergent for personal laundry if preferred
- Exercise books, paper and text books
- Care and/or medication for minor ailments, referral if necessary
- All meals
- Hot chocolate and snacks in the evening

Don't forget to bring photographs and small posters to decorate your bedroom – you will need blutac to display these.
